

Evita rehearsals are going fantastically well! Hello and welcome to **Oli Budino & lain Holding-Sutton**, who join the cast. Ticket sales are @ **34%** which is slightly ahead of MFL & Top Hat, so good news, but please continue to keep up the great work! Just a reminder about the **reserve a group booking procedure** that we have on most of our shows - including Evita. If you book 10 or more tickets for one single performance, you can reserve these tickets, paying **10% when you book** and the remainder, one calendar month before the show. A great way to book tickets for people without having to pay out of your pocket then collect the money in!

We have invested in the **RMS programming system** for the band, which will enhance the sound to make it appear like a much bigger orchestra - for example, 2 keyboards will sound like 4. It will really enhance the overall effect of the orchestra and, although it costs £300, it will help with the programming of the keyboards. Basildon Operatic used it for their production and it really did sound effective.

Auditions for Little Girl are this Saturday, so we will keep you posted on progress.
