When James finds out that Kipps has inherited a fortune, he pushes the younger man into letting him act as his financial adviser. He invests all of Kipps' money for him...and loses it all. Like his mother, James does not care for Kipps at all, but uses him ruthlessly to boost the family's wealth. Nasty piece of work but under the guise of a gentleman. Can double some scenes before we are introduced to his character if would like to.

**Carshot** – **CAN BE MR CARSHOT OR MISS CARSHOT.** Carshot works at Shalford's Bazaar as the floor-walker. A working-class character dedicated to the job which he /she has been doing for years. Friends with Kipps, Sid, Buggins, Pierce & Flo, but often pulls rank and is respectful of Shalford. Doubles in Company.

(Playing age – flexible!)
